This building provides training facilities and administrative support for Advanced Individual Training (AIT) programs and permanent pay military personnel, their dependents, civilian employees, retirees, Reserve and National Guard personnel, and personnel being mobilized for travel overseas. Major spaces will include an auditorium, five large classrooms, and an administrative office space for over 220 personnel.

The new two-story building has approximately 76,221 gross square feet of office, instructional, and auditorium. The construction is steel frame with metal deck and concrete floors, brick veneer exterior walls and a flat EPDM roof. The exterior of the building will take its architectural cues from the character of the surrounding buildings on base. The exterior character of the facility will contribute to the coordinated development of the Living-Training Area at Ft. Lee as defined in the Ft. Lee Installation Design Guide. The use of brick materials portrays an image of austerity and permanence, and the interior layout and finishes will contribute to a constructive learning and training environment. Green building practices and materials will be utilized with the stated goal of achieving a USGBC LEED silver certification.
